



1. Log in to Fracttal One and go to the settings menu located in the upper right corner.




2. Click on "Setting".




3. In the left side menu, select "Auxiliary Catalogs".




4. Within the drop-down options, choose "Connections".



5. Click on the "Add" button located in the lower right corner.




6. In the first field titled "Type", a menu will be displayed. Select the desired connection type. In this case, as an example, we will select Google Sheets.




7. Once the connection type is selected, fill in the fields below as needed. This information must be populated according to the JSON file that was previously downloaded during the Google account setup.
