Fracttal One uses time zones supported by IBM and verified with ISO 8601 to ensure accuracy in asset and task management.

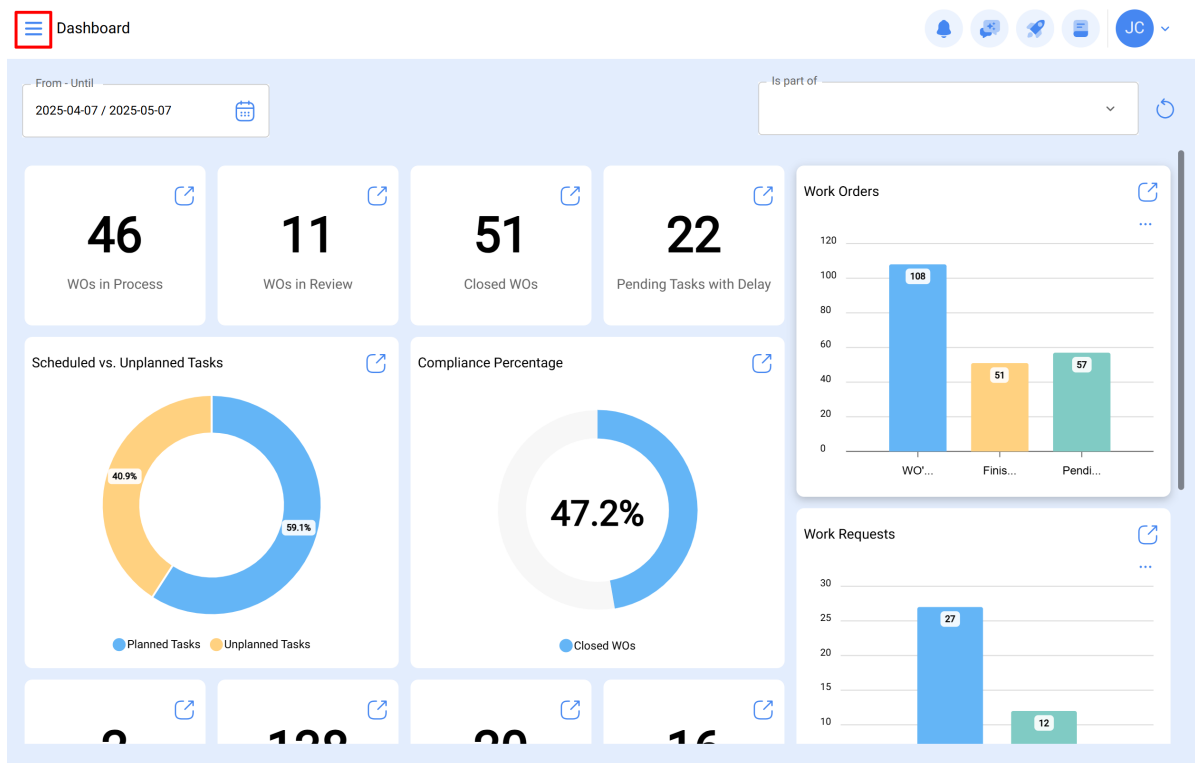
The platform allows users to customize their time zone according to a provided list. This setting is essential to ensure that the scheduled task dates are calculated correctly and to avoid errors in task creation.

How to set the time zone from the configuration module?

1. At the top right, click on the menu where your name appears.



2. Click on "Settings".
