

# How to Disable the Requirement to Complete the Failure Catalogs?

Fracttal One offers a configuration option that allows you to disable the requirement to complete the failure catalogs when registering a new Work Order or performing an intervention.

This option is disabled by default, but by enabling it, users can register OTs and perform interventions without having to fully complete the failure catalogs, thus optimizing the workflow.

## Steps to configure the option:

1. Access the **Configuration** module from the main menu.
2. Go to the **Modules** option and select Work Order.
3. In the Work Order section, find the option **Establish mandatory completion of the failure catalog**.  
Disable this option to remove the requirement to complete the failure catalogs when registering new OTs or performing interventions.
4. After enabling the option, save the changes for the configuration to take effect.
