



9. Select "Source" and specify the module, connection and action: In our example we will work with Google Sheet



- Module: Select the desired communication type (previously configured in the configuration module), such as Fracttal API, database, email, HTTP request or Google Sheets.
- **Connection:** Choose the communication settings previously established (This is previously done from the configuration module).
- Action: Define the action you want the communication to perform, in this case it is "read".

- 10. Once these options are completed and after selecting Google Sheet, the following fields will be enabled to be filled out
 - **spreadsheet_id:** Enter the snippet of the Google Sheets link you are working with.








15. Choose the name of the consumer created earlier from the "Configuration module".
