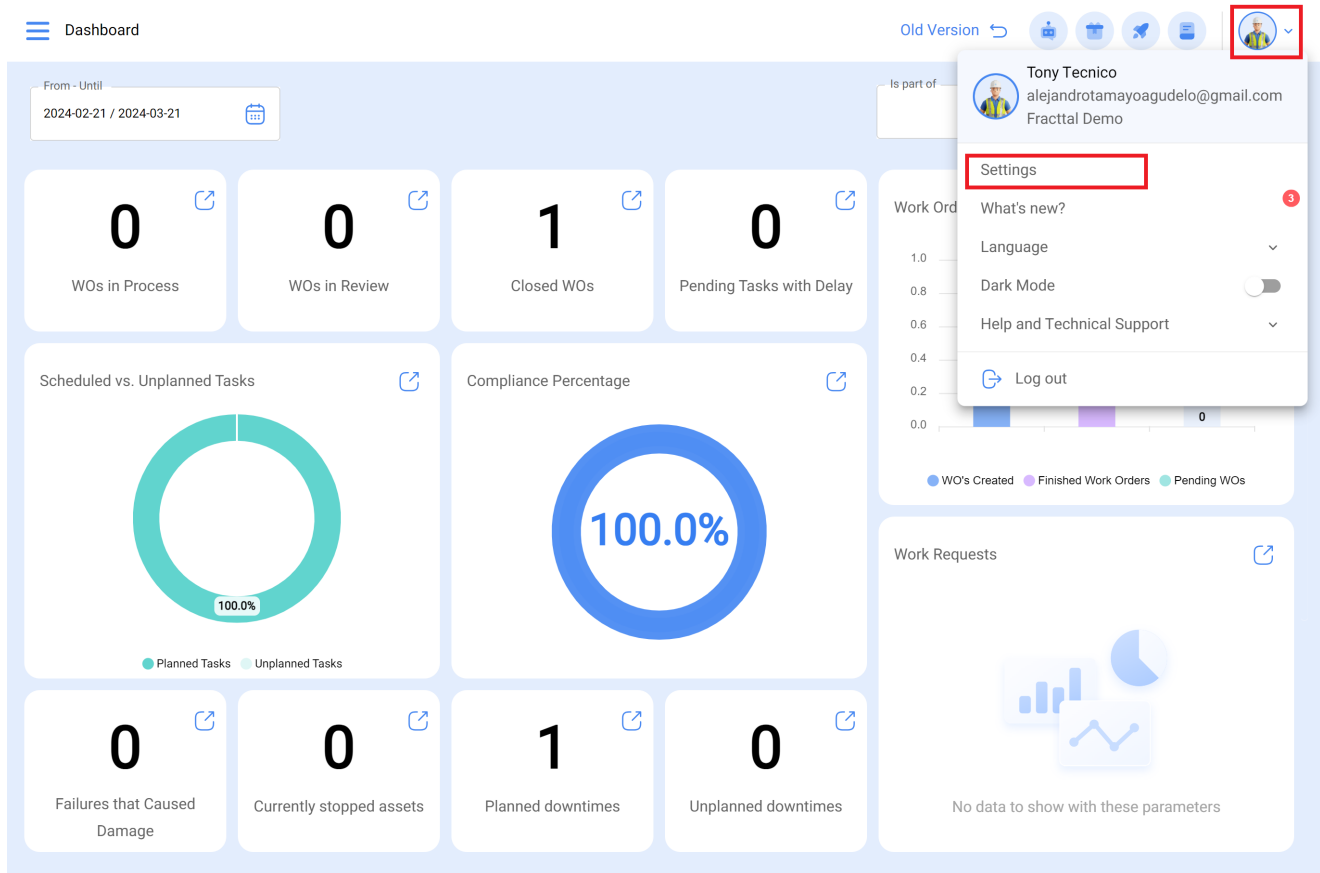


Where is the cloud disk capacity and used space?
