Para agregar un panel primero debes ingresar al módulo de “Fractal BI” para luego hacer clic en la opción de “seleccionar o crear paneles”.






1. **Descripción:** En este recuadro se agrega un título que haga referencia al enfoque que se quiere brindar en el dashboard que se va a crear.




2. **Rango de tiempo predeterminado:** En este recuadro se selecciona el rango de tiempo que se desea visualizar en el dashboard que vamos a crear.






